TEMPORARY DELAYS ON HUME HIGHWAY FROM WODONGA TO MULLENGANDRA

Motorists are advised temporary delays on the Hume Highway between Wodonga and Mullengandra next week due to the transportation of bridge girders for Hume Highway duplication project.

On Tuesday 9 September and Wednesday 10 September, eight girders will be transported under Police escort along the highway to the Newtons Road bridge site.

Delays are expected while the girders are being transported, and motorists are asked to drive with caution at these times.

On Wednesday 10 September and Thursday 11 September (weather permitting), the bridge girders will be lifted over Newtons Road for the construction of the new bridge over the highway at this location.

Motorists are advised Newtons Road will be closed to through traffic at the bridge site while the girders are being erected.

Traffic controllers will be on site to provide access to local properties beyond the bridge site, if required.

In the interests of safety, motorists are asked to be alert for workers when travelling through construction zones, and follow all temporary traffic controls.

The Hume Highway Southern Alliance duplication project involves duplicating 32km of the Hume Highway from Woomargama to Table Top.

The new bridge will run over Newtons Road, maintaining a safe passage for local residents and business along the existing road network.
