THE APPROVAL HOLDER MUST NOT TAKE WATER USING THE WORK SPECIFIED ON THIS APPROVAL UNLESS IN ACCORDANCE WITH DIRECTION FROM THE MINISTER WITH RESPECT TO THE ALLOCATION OF WATER FOR CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES ASSOCIATED WITH THE HUME HIGHWAY DUPLICATION PROJECT BETWEEN TABLE TOP AND WOOMARGAMA.

THE MINISTER ADVISES THAT A MAXIMUM OF 267 MEGALITRES OF WATER MAY BE EXTRACTED FROM THE WORK SPECIFIED ON THIS APPROVAL BETWEEN 1 JULY 2008 AND 30 JUNE 2009.

Schedule 2 – Conditions

1. THE APPROVAL HOLDER MAY ONLY TAKE WATER USING THE WORK SPECIFIED ON THIS APPROVAL FOR CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES ASSOCIATED WITH THE HUME HIGHWAY DUPLICATION PROJECT BETWEEN TABLE TOP AND WOOMARGAMA.
2. THE APPROVAL HOLDER MUST NOT TAKE WATER USING THE WORK SPECIFIED ON THIS APPROVAL UNLESS IN ACCORDANCE WITH DIRECTION FROM THE MINISTER WITH RESPECT TO THE ALLOCATION OF WATER FOR CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES ASSOCIATED WITH THE HUME HIGHWAY DUPLICATION PROJECT BETWEEN TABLE TOP AND WOOMARGAMA.

THE MINISTER ADVISES THAT A MAXIMUM OF 267 MEGALITRES OF WATER MAY BE EXTRACTED FROM THE WORK SPECIFIED ON THIS APPROVAL BETWEEN 1 JULY 2008 AND 30 JUNE 2009.

3. THE APPROVAL HOLDER MUST INSTALL, MAINTAIN AND OPERATE ANY DEVICE OR DEVICES FOR MEASURING THE VOLUME OF WATER EXTRACTED BY THE APPROVED WORK IN ACCORDANCE WITH ANY MANUFACTURER'S SPECIFICATIONS.
4. THE APPROVAL HOLDER MUST PROVIDE A CERTIFICATE ISSUED BY THE MANUFACTURER OR OTHER SUCH COMPETENT, QUALIFIED PERSON CERTIFYING THE ACCURACY OF DEVICE OR DEVICES USED FOR MEASURING THE VOLUME OF WATER EXTRACTED BY THE APPROVED WORKS, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ANY WRITTEN DIRECTION FROM THE MINISTER.
5. THE APPROVAL HOLDER MUST INFORM THE DEPARTMENT OF WATER AND ENERGY WITHIN SEVEN (7) DAYS IF THE DEVICE OR DEVICES USED FOR MEASURING THE VOLUME OF WATER TAKEN FROM THE APPROVED WORK CEASES TO RECORD WATER USAGE ACCURATELY. IN SUCH CASES THE APPROVAL HOLDER MUST NOTIFY THE DEPARTMENT OF:
 - (I) THE DURATION OF THE FAILURE OF THE MEASURING DEVICE(S), AND
 - (II) THE TOTAL HOURS THAT THE WORK WAS OPERATED WHILE THE MEASURING DEVICE WAS NOT FUNCTIONING.
6. THE APPROVAL HOLDER MUST RECORD DAILY METERED USAGE ON THE APPROVED PUMPING DIARY SHEETS PROVIDED BY THE DEPARTMENT. WRITTEN DAILY METERED USAGE RECORDS MUST BE PROVIDED TO THE DEPARTMENT BY FAX, E-MAIL OR POST, ON THE FIRST DAY OF EVERY MONTH.
7. THE HOLDER OF THE APPROVAL MUST CONSTRUCT AND MAINTAIN THE APPROVED WORK IN A SAFE AND PROPER MANNER THAT WILL MINIMISE THE POSSIBILITY OF DAMAGE BEING OCCASIONED BY IT, OR RESULTING FROM IT TO ANY PUBLIC OR PRIVATE INTEREST.

8. WHERE A FUEL DRIVEN MOTOR IS PART OF THE WORKS INSTALLED UNDER THIS APPROVAL, THE APPROVAL HOLDER MUST CONSTRUCT APPROPRIATE BUNDING AROUND THE MOTOR AND FUEL TANK TO CONTAIN ANY FUEL LEAKAGE OR SPILLAGE THAT MIGHT OCCUR.
9. THE HOLDER IS NOT AUTHORISED BY THIS APPROVAL TO REMOVE OR CLEAR ANY NATIVE VEGETATION OR TREES AS DESCRIBED WITHIN THE NATIVE VEGETATION CONSERVATION ACT 1997 OR NATIVE VEGETATION ACT 2003. ANY VEGETATION REMOVAL WILL REQUIRE SEPARATE WRITTEN APPROVAL FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF WATER AND ENERGY.
10. THE APPROVAL HOLDER MUST ENSURE THAT DURING THE CONSTRUCTION, OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE APPROVED WORKS, ANY ACTIVITY THAT RESULTS IN SOIL OR VEGETATION DISTURBANCE IS PERFORMED SO AS TO PREVENT SOIL EROSION AND THE ENTRY OF SEDIMENTS INTO ANY RIVER, LAKE, WATERBODY, WETLAND OR GROUNDWATER SYSTEM.
11. WORKS USED FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONVEYING, DISTRIBUTING OR STORING WATER FROM THE APPROVED WORK SHALL NOT BE CONSTRUCTED OR INSTALLED SO AS TO OBSTRUCT THE FREE PASSAGE OF FLOODWATERS FLOWING IN, TO OR FROM A RIVER OR LAKE.
12. THE APPROVAL HOLDER SHALL NOT ALLOW ANY TAILWATER/DRAINAGE TO DISCHARGE INTO OR ONTO:-
 - ANY ADJOINING PUBLIC OR CROWN ROAD;
 - ANY OTHER PERSONS LAND;
 - ANY CROWN LAND;
 - ANY RIVER, CREEK OR WATERCOURSE;
 - ANY NATIVE VEGETATION AS DESCRIBED UNDER THE NATIVE VEGETATION CONSERVATION ACT 1997;
 - ANY WETLANDS OF ENVIRONMENTAL SIGNIFICANCE.
13. THE APPROVAL HOLDER MUST EMPLOY BEST MANAGEMENT PRACTICE WITH RESPECT TO MITIGATING VEGETATION AND SOIL DISTURBANCE THAT MAY RESULT FROM VEHICULAR ACCESS TO THE APPROVED WORK.
14. THE APPROVAL HOLDER MUST EMPLOY BEST MANAGEMENT PRACTICE WITH RESPECT TO MITIGATING NOISE POLLUTION THAT MAY RESULT FROM THE INSTALLATION AND OPERATION OF THE APPROVED WORK.
15. THE APPROVAL HOLDER MUST IMMEDIATELY REPORT ANY POLLUTION EVENTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE APPROVED WORK TO THE POLLUTION LINE ON 131555 AND NOTIFY THE DEPARTMENT OF WATER AND ENERGY AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.
16. THE WORK SITE AND ANY ASSOCIATED ACCESS TRACKS ARE TO BE REHABILITATED TO THE SATISFACTION OF THE DEPARTMENT AT THE

COMPLETION OF THE HUME HIGHWAY DUPLICATION PROJECT BETWEEN
TABLE TOP AND WOOMARGAMA.

17. AT THE COMPLETION OF THE HUME HIGHWAY DUPLICATION PROJECT
BETWEEN TABLE TOP AND WOOMARGAMA, THE APPROVED WORK AND
ASSOCIATED INFRASTRUCTURE SHALL BE REMOVED AND THIS APPROVAL
WILL BE SUBSEQUENTLY CANCELLED.
